

9 Days Short Annapurna Base Camp Treks



Introduction

Annapurna region is famous for Annapurna base camp trekking (ABC). It is one of the amazing and popular trekking areas in part of the Annapurna region which is in the west part of the capital city Kathmandu. Annapurna region has many trekking routes such as Ghorepani poon hill, Annapurna round, Jomsom trekking, upper mustang trekking, Damphousse trekking, Nar Phu valley trekking, Ghandurk village trekking, Mardi Himal treks, and other various more options.

During the Annapurna base camp trekking, you will meet a lot of climbers, who are going towards the High mountain expedition, Annapurna 1(8067m) and Tent peak(5885m), Annapurna south (7200m) and many other.

So, Annapurna Base camp trekking is one of the beautiful and adventurous trekking routes in Nepal. You can plan it according to your holiday plan. You can choose whatever you like. You can plan it for 3week, 2week, 1week, 5 days, 3days or you can do one-day hiking also in Sarangkot or Dhampuse village

wherever you want. If you don't want to walk for long we have another option too, you can visit through helicopter and within 30 minutes you can go for ABC sightseeing and come back from Pokhara city or from Kathmandu.

During the Annapurna base camp, you can enjoy the snow-covered mountain which gives you the best views. Annapurna -1, Annapurna 2, Fistell Mountian, Nilgiri Himala, Ganga Punrna with other many smaller and taller Himalayas ranges.

Itinerary Details

Day 01 : Arrival to Kathmandu (1400m)

We will pick up your international airport then drive to our Hotel downtown city, then check- in a room be refresh and rest.if you are arriving early in the city, you can explore the town around near a hotel tourist sport and overnight Kathmandu.

Day 02 : Kathmandu to Pokhara (850 m) by tourist bus-drive 6 hour

After breakfast drive to via tourist bus around 6 hours to Pokhara and overnight Pokhara. Evening if you have time,u will have some walk around tourist sport the lake site in Pokhara. overnight in Pokhara.

Day 03 : Pokhara to – Jhinu Danda (Hot spring 1,780m/5,859ft): 6-7 hrs ~13km

After Breakfast drives to Nayapul Via car and Enjoy a pleasant sunrise and follow the ridge to Berethati village. From here, our trail descends to Sauli Bazaar, a Magar village at before continuing to the prosperous village to Bew bridge: a perfect lunch spot and The trail then winds up the Saylli Bazaar or Modi Khola Valley to the quaint village of Jhinu Danda. Enjoy the hot spring on the banks of the river, below the village.

Day 04 : Jhinu Danda – Dobhan (2,800m/9185ft), 6-7 hrs ~12km

After breakfast, Then gently descend to cross the Modi Khola before tackling the hill up to Sinuwa. Beyond, the trail passes through a dense forest of bamboo and rhododendron before descending to Bamboo (2,310m/7,580ft) on the banks of Chhomrong Khola Then continue through the uninhabited forest up to Dobhan, overnight Dobhan.

Day 05 : Dobhan – MBC (3,730m/12,230ft)- ABC (4,130m/13 550ft): 7-8 hrs ~12km

After Breakfast, we walk one of the best ways to ABC and you can enjoy bamboo forest and trail crosses a ravine and major avalanche chute shortly before Deurali (3,000m/9,840 ft). Continue ascending (more slowly) to the U-shaped entrance to the Sanctuary Valley and the Machhapuchhare Base Camp at 3,700m/12,136ft. Machhapuchhare (fishtail) is hidden behind a buttress, but Gangapurna and Annapurna III rise ahead and overnight ABC.

Day 06 : ABC – Sinuwa (1,980m/6,495ft): 7-8 hrs ~15km

Early morning enjoys with the best sunrise an Annapurna base camp Glacier then take breakfast town to walk to Sinuwa and overnight Sinuwa.

Day 07 : Sinwa – Ghandruk Phedi– Pokhara (910m/2,985ft): 5-6 hrs ~12km, 2- 3hrs drive, 55km

After Breakfast walk to Chhomrunig/Jhinu Dada and then continues to shady forest Ghandruk Village in new bridge then drive to Via jeep Nayapul and drive to Pokhara overnight Pokhara.

Day 08 : Pokhara-Kathmandu by Tourist Bus (6-7): hrs, 220km

After Breakfast drives to via tourist bus Pokhara to Kathmandu, it will be a 6-hour journey to Kathmandu and overnight in Kathmandu.

Day 09 : Departure - Days- from- kathmandu

We will drop to you our international Airport, any time regarding your departure schedule to fly home.

Cost Includes

- Airport / Hotel / Airport pick up & drop by private car or van. It depends on the group.
- Two nights accommodation in 3-star category hotel in Kathmandu located tourist center.

- Meals on full board (Breakfast, lunch, and dinner) during the in trekking.
- Local fresh fruits like orange, apple, banana, and grape etc.
- All accommodations during the trek.\
- Annapurna Trekking Map
- Both way Kathmandu to Pokhara and back to Kathmandu By Tourist Bus.
- All Ground Transport During The Trip to starting point and Ending Point via car.
- An experienced Government licensed holder guide and porter to carry your luggage during the trek(one potter for two)
- Food, drinks, accommodation, insurance, salary, equipment, transportation, local tax for Guide and
- porterGroup medical supplies (first aid kit will be available).
- If you need we will provide your sleeping bag, down jackets, Duffle bag and, if necessary etc.
- All necessary Government paper works and Conservation entry permits and TIMS Card etc.
- Travel & Rescue arrangement.
- All government taxes and Vat.

- International airfare.
- Nepal entry visa (You can obtain a visa easily upon your arrival at Nepal's Airport in Kathmandu).
