

Pisang Peak Climbing | Peak Climbing, fees & Permit itinerary 2018



Introduction

Pisang Peak (6091 m), most often climbed by the trekkers from the entire world falls in Annapurna Himalaya range of Nepal. Pisang Peak mounts on top of from Pisang village and yak grazing land in a constant slope of snow to its pinnacle. It is regarded as one of the trouble-free climbing peaks amongst the trekking mountains in Nepal. The path makes way up through sparse wood and meadow to arrive at the base camp of the peak from Pisang village to Kharka (4,380m) which is the finest spot for installing our camp. Furthermore, the High Camp is set up at the height of 5,400m climbing above the South-West Ridge.

Pisang Peak climb begins from Besisahar, from the gorge of the Marsyangdi River. The path will let you move through witnessing very distinct wild lives and plants and see gratifying peak of Mt. Manaslu as well as Lamjung Himal. The most appreciably the way meets at Dharapani while going by Larkya La. The pathway from here will necessitate long walk to the Pisang Peak. And then, moving further you will come to a place from where you can grab hold of the sight of entire panorama of the beautiful Annapurna Himalayan Range which is the most significant part of the trek. The trail after that rises up leaving the Manang valley to arrive at the apex of the Thorung Pass falling at 5416 m. After this you will get an opportunity to visit the famous temple of Muktinath.

Nepal Planets Treks and Expedition designs the Pisang Peak trekking as per your desire and schedule. Pisang peak route is counted among the easier paths of the Himalayan region, however, high level of bodily fitness is still required. Pisang peak has been constantly picked by trekkers and adventure seekers.

Day 06 : Dharapani to Chame (2,710m/8,891ft)
Day 07 : Chame to Pisang (3,700m/12,139ft)
Day 08 : Pisang to Upper Pisang (3,810 m/12,497ft)
Day 09 : Upper Pisang to Base Camp (4,380 m/14,36ft)
Day 10 : Base Camp to High Camp (5,400m/17,712ft)
Day 11 : Summit Pisang Peak (6,091m/19,980ft) and hike back to Upper Pisang (7-9 hrs)

Day 19 : Jomsom to Pokhara by Flight (25 minutes)
Day 20 : Pokhara to Kathmandu (1,300m/4,264 ft) 6-7 hrs drive.

Cost Includes

- Airport / Hotel / Airport pick up & drop by private tourist vehicle.
- Standard twin sharing accommodation in a three star hotel in Kathmandu; Breakfast included. (2/3 nights)
- All your standard Meals during the trek (Breakfasts, Lunches and Dinners).
- Lodges, Guesthouses accommodation during the trek (Twin sharing and occasionally dormitory room at guesthouse and Tented Camp at (Island Peak) ...here for Mera Peak...Base Camp).
- Group Climbing equipment (Climbing Rope, Ice Screw, Snow Bar, Ice hammer, Camping tents and Kitchen equipment at here Mera Peak,,,,,,(Island peak)base camp) Guide, cook and potter during the trekking.
- Climbing guide from Mera Peak (Island peak) base camp to the summit and back to Base camp.
- The required number of local staff and porters to carry your luggage during the trek (We assign one porter for every two guests).
- Food, accommodation, salary, insurance, equipment and medicine for all staff.
- Everest National Park permits and TIMS permit for trekking.
- Mera Peak (Island Peak) Climbing Permit.
- Garbage Deposit Fee.
- Kathmandu to kathmandu all trans portation via bus.
- Farewell dinner in typical Nepali Restaurant with cultural dance show on second last day.
- All our government taxes, vat, tourist service charges.
- Official expenses.

Cost Excludes

- Lunch and dinner whilst in Kathmandu.
- Travel insurance which covers emergency Rescue and Evacuation. (See the travel insurance page)
- International airfare and airport departure tax (see the international flights page)
- Nepal entry visa; you can obtain a visa easily upon your arrival at Tribhuwan
- International Airport in Kathmandu. (Tourist Visa with Multiple Entries for 30 days can be obtained by paying US \$ 40 or equivalent foreign currency. Similarly, Tourist Visa with Multiple Entries for 90 days can be obtained by paying US \$ 100. Please bring 2 copies of passport size photos).
